The Sunshine Coast Health Centre Scholarship

As a leader in addiction treatment, <u>Sunshine Coast Health Centre</u> is proud to announce a new scholarship opportunity to high school, undergraduate, and graduate students in clinical counselling, psychology, social sciences, medical, and nursing programs who are interested in working in addictions and mental health in Canada.

Addiction – Addiction is a condition that results when a person uses a substance (e.g. alcohol, cocaine, nicotine) or engages in an activity (e.g. gambling, sex, shopping) as part of a continued use/act that becomes compulsive and interferes with life activities such as work, relationships, or health. Users may not be aware that their behaviour is out of control and causing problems for themselves and others.

Addiction is commonly defined by the biological state in which the body adapts to the presence of a drug so that it no longer has the same effect (also known as tolerance). At Sunshine Coast Health Centre, we relate addiction to the fundamental motivation in humans including the need to make sense of his or her life and pursue a personally meaningful existence. Through a Meaning Therapy lens, we see addiction as a result of an individual's persistently frustrated attempts to live a personally meaningful life.

Clients in our <u>drug rehab</u> and <u>alcohol treatment programs</u> illustrate what life is like when an individual lacks personal meaning. In spite of having the outward appearance of success such as families, social circles, good jobs, and material possessions, our clients describe their inner world as one beset by boredom, anger, depression, loneliness, and a nagging feeling of emptiness like lost souls wandering without a direction. Our clients also report feeling as if they're different and do not fit in the world. This sense of separateness and brokenness lies at the heart of why individuals turns to drugs, alcohol or other forms of addiction.

To apply for this scholarship, please submit a 800-1000 word essay on one of the following topics:

- Examine the role of suffering and tragedy for human well-being and personal meaning.
- Discuss how Meaning Therapy and the Medical Model of Addiction can co-exist in a treatment setting and support persons seeking recovery from mental health and addiction.

In order to qualify for this scholarship, you must also be:

- Enrolled in a counselling, social work, psychology, medical/nursing, or relevant program
- Currently enrolled in the 2024/25 semesters at an accredited university or college in Canada*
